Call for Event Volunteers!!

The Sacramento-UC Davis Competition, like all other FIRST Competitions, is run entirely by volunteers during the 3 days of the event.

Typically 60 volunteers contribute blocks of 3 to 4 hours of their time in a range of roles that keep the event running smoothly. Volunteer duties range from helping with setup of the Game field and Pit areas, greeting VIPs and Volunteers, staffing the information booth, handling team liaison, food service and other duties. You do not need to have prior experience at a FIRST competition.
